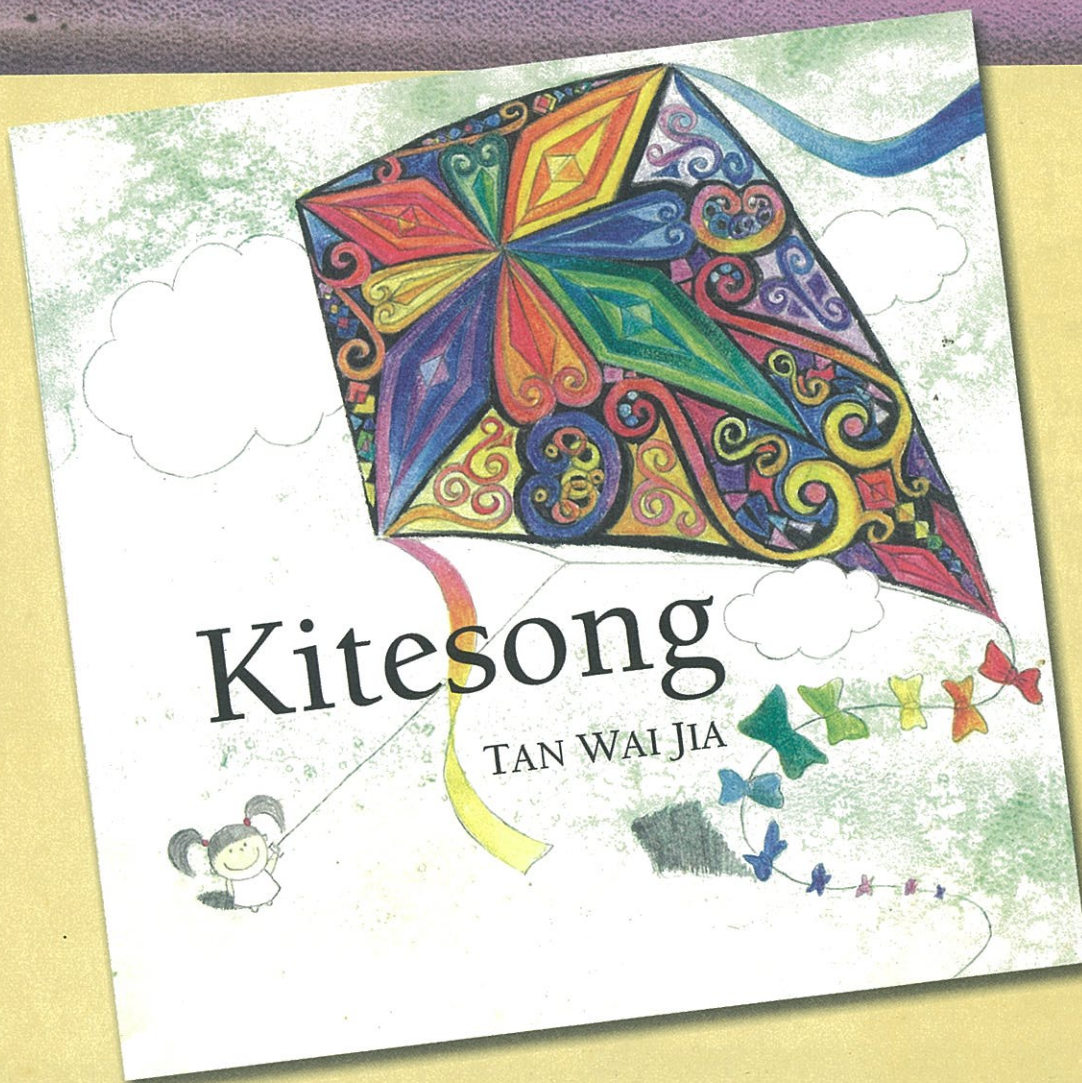


Run.
